### Come to the Music Saturday 24th August Bendigo

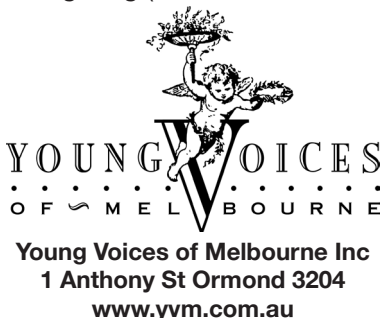
