Exaudi Camp

Everyone seemed to enjoy our new camp venue, and I certainly enjoyed making music with everyone. It was great to have nearly all the choir at camp this year! I have rebooked Lyrebird Park Camp for 2020.

Exaudi Fees for first half year are \$195, and are due March 8

Fees were due 4th March, but I have extended the discounted fee deadline for a few days, so that you can be reminded. Payments made after March 8 will be \$220, and all fees must be paid by the end of March. Account details for payment are on the calendar part of this newsletter. Please pay on time unless you are so rich you are happy to give us an extra \$25!

Scotland and Ireland Tour Updates

- Please check your **passports** so that you have a current passport when we start to collect passport details in the coming months.
- **Travel insurance** is not included in your tour fee, and you need to arrange this for yourselves. We have used travelinsurancedirect.com.au but there are many other providers to choose from.
- Final balance is due 1st April - \$3,000 for those with flights and \$734 for those who have organised their own flights.
